

#### Mini Lesson 020 - The Use of Articles: A, An, The

# **Explanation:**

Articles are small words that define whether a noun is specific or unspecific.

# - Indefinite Articles: A, An

- 'A' is used before words that begin with a consonant sound.
  - Example: \*a cat, a house, a university\*
- 'An' is used before words that begin with a vowel sound (a, e, i, o, u).
  - Example: \*an apple, an hour, an honest person\*

#### **Usage Tips:**

- Use 'a' or 'an' when mentioning something for the first time.
  - Example: \*I saw a dog.\* (Any dog, not a specific one)
- Use 'a' or 'an' when referring to a member of a group.
  - Example: \*She is an engineer.\* (Any engineer, not a specific one)

#### - Definite Article: The

- 'The' is used when referring to a specific item or items that are already known to the listener/reader.
  - Example: \*The cat is sleeping.\* (A specific cat)

#### **Usage Tips:**

- Use **'the'** when both the speaker and listener know the specific noun being discussed.
- Example: \*The teacher gave us homework.\* (A specific teacher both people know)
  - Use 'the' when there is only one of something.
    - Example: \*The sun is bright today.\*





# **Special Cases:**

- No article is used before uncountable nouns or plural nouns when speaking in general.
  - Example: \*Water is essential for life.\* (General statement)
- 'The' can be used with uncountable nouns when the context is specific.
  - Example: \*The water in this bottle is cold.\*
