



Mini Lesson 026 - The Past Continuous Tense

The **Past Continuous Tense** is used to describe actions that were ongoing at a specific time in the past. It's formed by using the past tense of the verb '**to be**' (was/were) followed by the **-ing** form of the main verb.

Uses of the Past Continuous Tense:

1. **Interrupted Actions:** To describe an action that was happening when another action interrupted it.

- Example: *I was reading a book when the phone rang.*

2. **Parallel Actions:** To describe two or more actions that were happening at the same time in the past.

- Example: *She was cooking dinner while he was watching TV.*

3. **Background Information:** To set the scene or describe the background situation in a story.

- Example: *The sun was shining, and the birds were singing.*

4. **Repeated Actions with 'Always':** To talk about actions that happened repeatedly in the past, often used with the word '**always**.'

- Example: *He was always losing his keys.*
